Committee Reports

1. Banquet Committee –Angie reported that on 2/7 there was a meeting held at Betty Klinger’s house to discuss the options for the banquet. Angie gave us two options; we could either have the meal catered and pay for the wrestlers or we could purchase pizza, soda, chips and pay for the entire meal for all attendees. After much discussion a straw vote was done and the result was to have the meal catered. We then discussed the option of the two caterers. We could go with White’s Catering at a price of \$10/head for adults and \$5.50 for children under 10; or we could go with S & M catering at a price of \$8.50/head for adults and \$4.50 for kids under 10. Again a straw vote was held and it was decided that we would go with S & M since we had used them in the past and they were the less expensive of the two choices. {Pizza was also discussed at a price of \$7.80/pizza, and we would need approximately 40 pizzas} The banquet date and time was set at 3/30/08 at 4:30pm at the Midd-West High School. Angie was directed to proceed with the planning and implementation of the banquet. {See action items}
2. Fundraising-The sandwich sale was very successful. We sold 893 sandwiches for a profit of \$1101.25.

2. President’s Report-1.Kim reported that the last time we had practice at West Snyder there was also a spelling bee that night. There was no control in the wrestling room, or in the gym where siblings and parents were waiting. Mr. Harrison and Mr. Edmiston both came over to ask the parents, coaches and kids to please quiet down. Kim also reported that both he and Nicci had received a call from Mr. Harrison regarding this incident. A letter would be forth-coming from Mr. Harrison about the future of holding practice at West Snyder. {Should be noted that on the original schedule we were planning the following rotation: hold 2 weeks at Midd-West HS and 1 week at West Snyder.
